In pursuance of G.O.Ms. No. 81 Finance (HR-I Plg, & Policy) Department dated: 22.08.2026, State Level Police Recruitment Board, Andhra Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as SLPRB, AP) invites applications for the following posts, through **ONLINE** (<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>) mode only. The number of vacancies indicated above is only provisional and is liable for change without giving any notice.

2. SLPRB, AP, reserves the right to notify the modifications with regard to any aspect of recruitment any time during the process of recruitment. Candidates must read the notification carefully, understand and accept all the terms and conditions specified therein before submission of application form. By submission of application form by the candidate, it is construed that he / she has read the notification and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down there under.

3. The candidate will be required to submit (upload) a copy of **passport size photo, signature, SSC certificate, community certificate (for BC/SC/ST candidates), EWS and Non-Creamy Layer certificate**, if applicable, while submitting Online Application Form.

4. The exact dates for submission of the Online Application Form will be notified separately through a Press Release and will be published on the official website shortly. Only candidates who fulfil all the prescribed eligibility conditions and other requirements shall be eligible to apply. Candidates are advised to carefully verify and satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility before submitting the application. The application shall be

submitted **online only** through the official website (<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>).

5. Rules Governing the Posts: -

This recruitment to the posts mentioned as above (Post Code Nos. 26 and 27) is being made as per the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Police (Stipendiary Cadet Trainee) Rules issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No 315 Home (Pol.C) Department, dated 13-10-1999 and the amendments thereon.

6. The rule of Special Representation (reservation) i.e., EWS, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC(Group-I, Group-II and Group-III) and ST as provided in Rule 22 of A.P. State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 and further amendments thereon.

7. Reservation for Special Categories:-

The vacancies reserved for Special Categories i.e., Home Guard (HG), Children of Police Personnel (CPP); National Cadet Corps (NCC); Ex.Servicemen (Ex.Ser) and as per details given in Para 20 below shall be adjusted in horizontal manner on compartmentalized basis i.e., the reservation of Special Category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in respective communal category to which the candidate belongs. Vacancies which remain unfilled in any of the special categories for want of eligible candidates shall be added to the vacancies to be filled by the direct recruitment.

Note: Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the Special Categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from among the eligible candidates belonging to the respective Communal Category.

8. BC RESERVATION & Non-CREAMY LAYER:

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes shall produce the Community Certificate and a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate issued by the competent authority of the Government of Andhra Pradesh for claiming reservation and age relaxation. The NCL Certificate shall have been issued on or after 01.04.2026.

Candidates who fail to produce a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification at the PMT/PET Centre shall

be considered under the Open Category (OC), subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions, such candidates shall not be permitted, under any circumstances, to subsequently change their category or claim reservation or age relaxation under the Backward Classes category at their option.

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes who fall under the Creamy Layer shall not be entitled to claim reservation or age relaxation admissible to Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer).

9. Pertaining to Backward Classes, Relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 13(B)(b)(ii)), and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' or 'any category in BC-E group' will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation pending before the Hon'ble Courts. However, relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 13(B) (b)(ii)) and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' is applicable to Sl. No. 1 to 14 of BC-E group as per interim order dated 25-03-2010 in Civil Appeal No(s). 2628-2637 of 2010 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. As per the G.O. Ms. No. 23, Backward Class Welfare Dept., dated 07.07.2007, the castes mentioned in Sl. No. 15 are treated as 'OC' category.

10. SC/ST RESERVATION:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes should submit the Latest Community certificate, issued by the competent authority of A.P. State to claim reservation and age relaxation. The candidates belong to SC community should submit the latest community certificate based on the ordinance issued by the Government in A.P. Ordinance No.2 of 2025, dated 17.04.2025 as per the SC Sub-Classification (Group-I, Group-II and Group-III).

11. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION CATEGORY

Candidates who are local to AP State as per the definition given in Presidential Order, 2025 and belonging to Economically Weaker Section Category (as per the G.O.Ms.No.73, GA (Services-D) Department, dated 04.08.2021) whose gross annual family income is below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for the benefit of reservation. The Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. The applicants should submit the EWS certificate which was issued on or after 01.04.2026 by the Tahsildar concerned.

12. The requisite educational qualification, age, physical standards, procedure to be followed for selection etc are given below. The candidates must carefully read, in their own interest, the instructions given in this notification as well as “General Instructions” in the online application, before filling the online application form.

13. Eligibility Conditions:

A. For the post mentioned against Post Code Nos: 26 & 27 – only Men are eligible.

B. Age Limit:

(a) General Rule

(i) A person who is a local candidate of the State of Andhra Pradesh, is serving in the Andhra Pradesh Police Department as a Home Guard as on the date of issuance of the Notification, and has rendered not less than 360 days of service as a Home Guard during the preceding period of two years, and who continues to be in service as a Home Guard in the State of Andhra Pradesh as on the date of the Notification, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 32 years as on 1st July, 2026, i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1994 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

(ii) For the post code No. 26

In the case of all other candidates, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 24 years as on 1st July, 2026 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 2002 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

(iii) For the Post Code Nos: 27

In the case of all other candidates, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 27 years as on 1st July, 2026, i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1999 and not later than 1st July, 2008.

(b) Age Relaxation:-

The upper age limit prescribed in para **(13) (B)(a)(i)(ii)(iii)** above will be relaxed as under;

(i) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to Economically Weaker Section Category.

- (ii) Upto a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Backward Class(Non-Creamy Layer) or a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe.
- (iii) Length of regular service limited upto a maximum of five years if a candidate is an employee of A.P. State Government (Employees of APTRANSCO, Discoms, APGENCO, Corporations, Municipalities, Local bodies etc. are not entitled for age relaxation).
- (iv) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered in the Army, Naval or Air Force of the Union for the candidates who served in the Army, Naval or Air Force of the Union.
- (v) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC provided the candidate rendered a minimum service of 6 months as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC.
- (vi) Upto a maximum of three years if a candidate is a retrenched temporary employee in the State Census Department with a minimum service of 6 months during 1991

The prescribed age limits shall not be relaxed under any circumstances, except as specifically provided above.

NOTE 1: - The date of birth accepted by the SLPRB, AP is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. The document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, service records and etc., will not be accepted.

NOTE 2: Due to various Age relaxations, Age validation is not being done in the Online Application Form. It is the responsibility of the Candidates to satisfy themselves about their Age eligibility for the Post(s) applied for.

14) Minimum Educational Qualification

(i) For Post Code No. 26

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must have passed SSC or any other examination recognized by the State Government as being equivalent to SSC and must possess an Industrial Training Institutional Certificate in Wiremen or Mechanic Motor Vehicle or Mechanic Diesel or Fitter.

(ii) For Post Code No. 27

- a) As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must have passed Intermediate examination or any other examination recognized as its equivalent by the State Board of Intermediate Education;

(or)

SSC or any other examination recognized by the State Government as being equivalent to SSC and must possess an Industrial Training Institutional Certificate in Auto Electrician or Mechanic Motor vehicle or Mechanic Diesel or Fitter.

- b) Must possess a valid Light Motor Vehicle (LMV) Driving Licence continuously for a period of **not less than two years** as on the date of notification.

Note: The candidates who possess higher qualification than the prescribed one will also be considered for selection on par with the candidates who possess the prescribed qualification.

15. MEDICAL STANDARDS:

- a. Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows:

- ii) Each eye must have a full field of vision.
- iii) Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification.
- b. The candidate should possess sound health and be free from any bodily defect or infirmity which will render him unfit.
- c. Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any post specified in this rule:
- i) Physically handicapped.
- ii) Knocking-knees, pigeon chest, flat feet, Varicose veins, Hammer toes, fractured limbs, decayed teeth, stammering, hard of hearing and abnormal psychological behaviour.

NOTE: In order to avoid disappointment, candidates are advised to have themselves examined by a **Civil Surgeon** before applying for the examination to ensure that they meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards.

16. FEE STRUCTURE

- a. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the OCs (including EWS) and BC categories, applying for the posts of Stipendiary Constables (Mechanics) (Men) and Stipendiary Constables (Drivers) (Men) in Police Transport Organization, shall pay a fee of Rs.300/- towards processing of the application, PMT/PET, Written Examinations, etc.
- b. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the SC and ST categories shall pay a fee of Rs.150/- only.
- c. Candidates who are Non-Local to the State of Andhra Pradesh shall be treated under the Open Category (OC) and shall pay a fee of Rs.300/-.

17. Mode of Payment of Fee:

I Step: Candidate has to visit SLPRB Website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to pay prescribed Registration Fee, through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking or any other mode made available on the SLPRB Website by providing his details such as Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number, Community and SSC Hall Ticket Number or its equivalent.

II Step: After making the Payment, Candidate has to visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> to submit the Online Application Form. After making payment of fee, if the candidate fails to press “submit” in the Online Application Form, such cases shall be rejected without giving any notice, and fee once paid shall not be refunded in any case.

III Step: As there is no Preliminary Written Test for the technical posts of Stipendiary Constables (Mechanics) (Men) and Stipendiary Constables (Drivers) (Men) Candidates shall visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> at the appropriate time and regularly check the website for further instructions regarding the schedule and venue of the PMT/PET and Trade Test/Driving Test.

Note: Those who intend to apply for both categories of posts (Post Code No 26 & 27), need to submit only **one application form**.

18. CANDIDATES SHOULD ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The candidates applying for the recruitment should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions as given in the notification. Their admission at all stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional and subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Admit card / Hall ticket to the candidate will not imply that his candidature has been finally cleared by the SLPRB. The SLPRB will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the Genuineness of original documents only after the candidate has finally qualified.

19. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME:

The Selection Procedure/Scheme will be as follows:

(i) For the post code No. 26:

(a) Preliminary Written Test:- There will be no preliminary Written Test. Candidates have to report for verification of certificates and Physical Measurements Test which will be mentioned in the Hall Tickets after registration.

(b) Physical Measurement Test: The candidates should meet the following requirements

- a) Height: Must not be less than 162 cms.
- b) Chest: Must not be less than 84 cms round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 4 cms.

NOTE : Provided that the candidates who belongs to Aboriginal Scheduled Tribes (ABO-ST) in the Agency areas of 1. Vizanagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4.Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5.Eluru and 6.Parvathipuram Manyam Districts should meet the following requirements:

- a) Height: Must not be less than 160 cms.
- b) Chest: Must not be less than 80 cms round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 3 cms.

Note: The Height and Chest measurements of the candidates shall be recorded using a digital measurement system. The Height of the candidate

shall be measured while the candidate is standing upright in the correct position.

c) Physical Efficiency Test (PET) : All candidates declared qualified in PMT shall be required to attend 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) which is qualifying. Candidates must complete the run in 10 Minutes or less time.

Note:

1. The events shall be conducted using electronic devices/equipment.
2. Spike shoes shall not be permitted during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
3. The time taken by the candidate in each event shall be recorded accurately using the prescribed electronic timing system. Any fraction of a millisecond or delay beyond the prescribed measurement shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of calculation of time.
4. Once any event is conducted as part of the recruitment process, the result thereof shall be treated as final. No second chance, re-test or re-conduct of the event shall be permitted under any circumstances.

d) Trade Test: The candidates who qualify in the above Physical Measurements Test and Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear and qualify in a Trade test. The Chairman, State Level Police Recruitment Board will constitute a committee for conducting this test with the officers from Police Transport Organization, Road Transport Corporation and Road Transport Authority.

The candidates must qualify in the Trade Test carrying a maximum of 100 marks in ten parameters mentioned below, out of which at least 50 marks must be obtained.

The marks secured in the Trade Test shall not be counted for preparation of final merit and the test is qualifying in nature

Note:

Participation in all prescribed events shall be compulsory for every candidate, including candidates belonging to Special Categories.

e) Written Examination:

Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Measurements Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Trade Test shall be required to appear for a written examination in one paper (three hours duration) as given below. The syllabus is given in Annexure-I.

NOTE:

- (1) (a) The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Final Written Test is 40% for OCs(Including EWS); 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks he will be disqualified.
- (b) Candidates who belongs to Special Categories i.e. Ex. Servicemen, HG, CPP and NCC shall secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category in which he belongs.
- (2) Questions in the Paper will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu Languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose, candidates should bring Blue/ Black Ball Point pens along with them.

f) Final Selection: The final selection of the candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in written examination (200 marks), for the candidates who qualified in Physical Measurement Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Trade Test. The provisions of

“The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are not applicable.

g) Preference: When two or more candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the candidate who was born earlier.

(ii) For the post code no 27:

(a) Preliminary Written Test:- There will be no preliminary Written Test. Candidates have to report for verification of certificates and Physical Measurements Test which will be mentioned in the Hall Tickets after registration.

(b) Physical Measurement Test: The candidates should meet the following requirements

- a) Height: Must not be less than 162 cms.
- b) Chest: Must not be less than 84 cms round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 4 cms.

NOTE : Provided that the candidates who belongs to Aboriginal Scheduled Tribes (ABO-ST) in the Agency areas of 1. Vizanagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4.Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5.Eluru and 6.Parvathipuram Manyam Districts should meet the following requirements:

- a) Height: Must not be less than 160 cms.
- b) Chest: Must not be less than 80 cms round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 3 cms.

Note: The Height, Chest and Weight measurements of the candidates shall be recorded using a digital measurement system. The Height of the candidate shall be measured while the candidate is standing upright in the correct position.

c) Physical Efficiency Test (PET) : All candidates declared qualified in PMT shall be required to attend 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) which is qualifying. Candidates must complete the run in 10 Minutes or less time.

Note-1:

- 1. The events shall be conducted using electronic devices/equipment.
- 2. Spike shoes shall not be permitted during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).

3. The time taken by the candidate in each event shall be recorded accurately using the prescribed electronic timing system. Any fraction of a millisecond or delay beyond the prescribed measurement shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of calculation of time.
4. Once any event is conducted as part of the recruitment process, the result thereof shall be treated as final. No second chance, re-test or re-conduct of the event shall be permitted under any circumstances.

Note-2:

Participation in all prescribed events shall be compulsory for every candidate, including candidates belonging to Special Categories.

d) Driving Test: The candidates who qualify in the above Physical Measurements Test and Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear and qualify a driving test. The Chairman, State Level Police Recruitment Board will constitute a committee for conducting this test with the officers from Police Transport Organization, Road Transport Corporation and Road Transport Authority.

The candidates must qualify in the Driving Test carrying a maximum of 100 marks in eight parameters mentioned below out of which at least 50 marks must be obtained.

The marks secured in the Driving Test shall not be counted for preparation of final merit and the test is qualifying in nature

e) Written Examination:

Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Measurements Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Driving Test shall be required to appear for a written examination in one paper (three hours duration) as given below. The syllabus is given in Annexure II.

NOTE:

(1) (a) The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Final Written Test is 40% for OCs(including EWS), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks he will be disqualified.

(b) Candidates who belongs to Special Categories i.e. Ex. Servicemen, HG, CPP and NCC shall secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category in which he belongs.

(2) Questions in the Paper will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu & Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue/Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose, candidates should bring Blue/Black Ball Point pens along with them.

f) Final Selection: The final selection of the candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their score in written examination (200 marks), for the candidates who qualified in Physical Measurement Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Driving Test. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are not applicable.

g) Preference: When two or more candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the candidate who was born earlier.

20. Special Representation for Special Categories:

As per G.O.Ms.No. 173, Home (Legal-II) Department, dated:16.09.2026, all vacancies arising under the Special Categories shall be applicable

exclusively to candidates who are local to the State of Andhra Pradesh, in accordance with “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025” and the rules and orders in force.

As per G.O. Ms No. 87 of HOME (LEGAL-II) dated: 15th July, 2016 and subsequent amendments thereon, the vacancies reserved for special categories shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner on compartmental basis, that is the reservation of special category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective communal category to which the candidate belongs.

A. Percentage of Quota in the Special Categories:

(i) For Post Code No.26: 10% for Home Guards (HG); 3% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP); 2% for Ex-Servicemen (Ex-Ser) and 1% for National Cadet Corps (NCC).

(iii) For Post Code No.27: 20% for Home Guards (HG); 3% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP); 2% for Ex-Servicemen (Ex-Ser) and 1% for National Cadet Corps (NCC).

B. Candidates who claim reservation / quota under following special categories should satisfy the following conditions: -

- i. Home Guard:** A person who is a local candidate of the State of Andhra Pradesh, is serving in the Andhra Pradesh Police Department as a Home Guard as on the date of issuance of the Notification, and has rendered not less than 360 days of service as a Home Guard during the preceding period of two years, and who continues to be in service as a Home Guard in the State of Andhra Pradesh as on the date of the Notification, shall be eligible to avail the reservation earmarked for Home Guards, subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions.
- ii. CPP:** Children of Police Personnel up to the rank of Inspector of Police in AP Police Department who are either in service or retired or dead, will come under this special category.

NOTE: Children of police personnel who were compulsorily retired or removed or dismissed from service will not be considered for quota under “Children of Police Personnel” (CPP).

- iii. Ex-Servicemen:** Candidates who claim reservation as Ex-Servicemen should satisfy the conditions mentioned in Rule 2 (16) of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules and should have the necessary certificate from the competent authority.

“Ex-Servicemen” means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as a non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Research Engineering Force, Lok-Sahayak Sena and the para-military forces, i.e., Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police, Central Industrial Security Force, Central Secretariat Security Force, Assam Rifles and Railway Protection Force and

- (i) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or
- (ii) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
- (iii) who has been released, otherwise than on his own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment or
- (iv) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct, inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories; namely:-
 - (a) pension holders for continuous embodied services;
 - (b) person with disability attributable to military services; and
 - (c) gallantry award winners.

Explanation: The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of ex-servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.

- iv) NCC – National Cadet Corps:** Candidates who possess NCC ‘C’ certificate will be preferred. If sufficient candidates are not available, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘B’ certificate will be considered. If vacancies still remain unfilled, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘A’ certificate will be considered.

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation / quota under NCC (A/B/C) should submit the necessary certificate.

Note:

- i) Candidates who claim reservation/quota under Home Guard and CPP should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificate as per annexure IV and V respectively. The certificate(s) pertaining to Home Guard and CPP should be obtained on or after the date of notification from the competent authority. **The certificate obtained before the date of notification is not valid and will not be entertained.**

21. Recruitment to all the posts, including those of special categories, shall be made as per the provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local cadres and regulation of direct recruitment) Order, 2025” and further amendments thereon.

22. The selection of the candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of the genuineness of original certificates, antecedents and medical examination.

23. ANTECEDENTS VERIFICATION: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his character and antecedents are such as to qualify him for such service.

24. DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT: The candidates falling under the following categories shall be disqualified for appointment, under these rules:

- i. If any document produced by the candidate is found fake or forged as established during antecedent verification.
- ii. If the candidate himself or through his relatives or friends or any other has canvassed or endeavoured to enlist extraneous support whether from official or non-official sources for his candidature.
- iii. A person (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person. Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is

permissible under the personal law applicable to such person, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- iv. A person who has been dismissed from the services of a State or Central Government or from the service of any Central or State Government undertaking or local body or other authority.
- v. A person who has been convicted for any offence or facing trial in any court of law, except for offences of technical nature like Motor Vehicles Act Violations, J.J. Act (Juvenile Justice) Violations, shall stand disqualified.
- vi. A person who is involved in an offence involving moral turpitude is disqualification for appointment.

25. In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or ineligibility being detected at any time even after appointment, he will be discharged from service forthwith by the appointing authority without giving any notice.

26. Stipend and Allowance: During the period of institutional training (regular as well as extended) candidates shall be eligible for stipend as fixed by the Government from time to time. On successful completion of training, they will be appointed in the regular time scale of pay as mentioned under Para 26 below.

27. After successful completion of training, they will be appointed in the regular time scale of Pay as mentioned herein.

Scale of pay: For Post Code Nos. 26 & 27: **Rs 25,220 – 80,910 /-** as per the Revised Pay Scale 2022.

28. The employees who are appointed on or after **01-09-2004** are covered by the Contributory Pension Scheme.

29. The candidates who were provisionally selected for any one of the post specified in this notification and is an employee of A.P. State Government / any other State Government / Central Government / any Government undertaking can join training only after relief / resignation in the earlier service.

30. Time limit for submission of attestation forms (or) other relevant documents (or) attend medical examination (or) join the training: The candidates who are provisionally selected for any one of the post specified in this notification will be asked to submit an attestation form, produce other relevant documents and attend medical examination on a specified date. The candidates who become eligible to be sent for training will be asked to join the training on a specified date. If any candidate fails to respond and fails to submit the necessary form or document or attend the medical examination or join the training on a specified date, his selection may be cancelled without prior notice to the candidate.

31. General Instructions:

- i. Particulars furnished by the Candidates in the Application Form will be taken as final. Candidates should, therefore, be very careful in uploading / submitting the Application Form Online.
- ii. Incomplete / Incorrect Application Form will be summarily rejected. The information, if any, furnished by the Candidate subsequently in any form will not be entertained by the SLPRB, AP under any circumstances. Candidates should be careful in filling up the Application Form before submission. If any lapse is detected at any stage of the recruitment process, the candidature will be instantly rejected.
- iii. Serving personnel of the Army, Navy, Air Force or Territorial Army of the Indian Union who are due to retire within one year from the last date prescribed for submission of Online Application Form shall produce a “No Objection Certificate (NOC)” issued by their respective Unit Commanding Officer, duly indicating the Personnel Number, Rank, Name, Unit and Date of Retirement, or the Retirement Order, as applicable, for claiming age relaxation and/or reservation under the Ex-Servicemen category.
- iv. Based on the information submitted by the candidate, in Online Application Form, (i.e. Community, Local & Non-Local, Ex-servicemen certificate, EWS and Non-Creamy Layer etc.), results will be issued. If any information is later found false, the candidature of such candidate shall be rejected, without giving notice and prior intimation.
- v. Candidates must submit all the relevant certificates during the process of physical verification of the certificates at the time of PMT/PET. No

further submission of certificate will be entertained/received by SLPRB, AP at later stage.

- vi. The selection list shall be prepared based on the preferences indicated by the candidate in the Application Form as per the eligibility (Post Preference). Candidature will not be considered against those Posts which were left blank / or were left unfilled by the Candidate.
- vii. Candidates are advised to carefully read and understand all the instructions before submitting the Online Application Form. By submitting the application form, the candidate has acknowledged acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the notification.
