2. SLPRB, AP, reserves the right to notify the modifications with regard to any aspect of recruitment any time during the process of recruitment. Candidates must read the notification carefully, understand and accept all the terms and conditions specified therein before submission of application form. By submission of application form by the candidate, it is construed that he / she has read the notification and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down there under.

3. The candidate will be required to submit (upload) a copy of **passport size photo, signature, SSC certificate, community certificate (for BC/SC/ST candidates), EWS and Non-Creamy Layer certificate**, if applicable, while submitting STAGE I Online Application Form.

4. The exact dates for submission of the Online Application Form/Preliminary Written Test will be notified separately through a Press Release and will be published on the official website shortly. Only candidates

who fulfil all the prescribed eligibility conditions and other requirements shall be eligible to apply. Candidates are advised to carefully verify and satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility before submitting the application. The application shall be submitted **online only** through the official website (<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>).

6. RULES GOVERNING THE POSTS:

- This recruitment to the posts mentioned as above (Post Code Nos.11 & 12) is being made as per the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Police (Stipendiary Cadet Trainee) Rules issued by the Government of Andhra

Pradesh in G.O. Ms. No.315, Home (Pol.C) Department, dated 13-10-1999 and subsequent amendments thereon.

- b) Recruitment to the post in the SPF Department (Post Code No.31) is being made as per the provisions of G.O.Ms. No.208, Home (Pol.F) Department, dt.20.08.1999 and subsequent amendments thereon.

7. WOMEN RESERVATION:

Under direct recruitment, 33 ¹/₃ % of vacancies in each category (Communal Category), including EWS, are reserved for women for the Post Code No. 11 and 20 % of vacancies in each category (Communal Category), including EWS, are reserved for women for the Post Code No. 12 under direct recruitment. The reservation will be **a horizontal reservation** following principle of sufficiency i.e., the reservation of women candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which the women candidate belongs, in relaxation to relevant rules relating to Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996 and further amendments thereon. In the event of non-availability of eligible and suitable women candidates in a particular year, the vacancies reserved for them shall not be carried forward to the subsequent year and shall be filled up by men candidates of respective category.

8. The rule of Special Representation (reservation) i.e., EWS, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC(Group-I, Group-II, Group-III) and ST as provided in Rule 22 of A.P. State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 shall be applicable.

9. RESERVATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

The vacancies reserved for Special Categories i.e. Ex.Servicemen (Ex-Ser.), Police Executive (PE), Police Ministerial (PM), Meritorious Sportspersons (MSP), Children of Police Personnel (CPP), Children of deceased and Incapacitated Police Personnel (CDI), National Cadet Corps (NCC) and Children of SPF members including Retired / Deceased / Incapacitated members (CSPF), Members of Special Protection Force and as per details given in **Para 23** below shall be adjusted in horizontal manner on compartmentalized basis i.e., the reservation of Special Category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in respective communal category to which the candidate belongs. Vacancies which remain unfilled in any of the special categories for want of eligible candidates shall be added to the vacancies to be filled by the direct recruitment.

Note: Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the Special Categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates shall be filled from among the eligible candidates belonging to the respective Communal Category.

10. BC RESERVATION & NON-CREAMYLAYER:

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes shall produce the Community Certificate and a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) Certificate issued by the competent authority of the Government of Andhra Pradesh for claiming reservation and age relaxation. The NCL Certificate shall have been issued on or after 01.04.2026.

Candidates who fail to produce a valid NCL Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification at the PMT/PET Centre shall be considered under the Open Category (OC), subject to fulfilment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions, such candidates shall not be permitted, under any circumstances, to subsequently change their category or claim reservation or age relaxation under the Backward Classes category at their option.

Candidates belonging to the Backward Classes who fall under the Creamy Layer shall not be entitled to claim reservation or age relaxation admissible to Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer).

11. Pertaining to Backward Classes, Relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 15(B)(b)(ii)), and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' or 'any category in BC-E group' will be subject to the adjudication of the litigation pending before the Honourable Courts. However, relaxation in upper age limit (as given in para 15(B) (b)(ii)) and / or reservation to 'BC-E group' is applicable to Sl. No. 1 to 14 of BC-E group as per interim order dated 25-03-2010 in Civil Appeal No(s). 2628-2637 of 2010 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. As per the G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Class Welfare Dept., dated 07.07.2007, the castes mentioned in Sl. No. 15 are treated as 'OC' category.

12. SC/ST RESERVATION:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes should submit the Latest Community certificate, issued by the competent authority of A.P. State to claim reservation and age relaxation. The candidates belong to SC community should submit the latest community certificate based on the ordinance issued by the Government in A.P.

Ordinance No.2 of 2025, dated 17.04.2025 as per the SC Sub-Classification (Group-I, Group-II and Group-III).

13. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION CATEGORY:

Candidates who are local to AP State as per the definition given in Presidential Order, 2025 and belonging to Economically Weaker Section Category (as per the G.O.Ms.No.73, GA (Services-D) Department, dated 04.08.2021) whose gross annual family income is below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for the benefit of reservation. The Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. The applicants should submit the EWS certificate which was issued on or after 01.04.2026 by the Tahsildar concerned.

14. The requisite educational qualification, age, physical standards, procedure to be followed for selection etc are given below. The candidates must carefully read, in their own interest, the instructions given in this notification as well as “General Instructions” in the online application, before filling the online application form.

15. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- A)** i. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 11 & 12; Men & Women are eligible.
- ii. For the post mentioned against Post Code No. 31 only Men are eligible.

B) Age Limit:

a. General Rule

For the Post Code Nos. 11, 12 & 31:

Must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 27 years as on 1st July, 2026 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1999, and not later than 1st July, 2005.

b. Age Relaxation:

The upper age limit prescribed in para 15 (B) (a) above will be relaxed as under:

- (i) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to Economically Weaker Section Category.
- (ii) Up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Backward Class (Non-Creamy layer) or a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe.
- (iii) Length of regular service limited upto a maximum of five years if a candidate is an employee of AP State Government. Employees of APTRANSCO, DISCOMs, APGENCO, Corporations, Municipalities, Local bodies etc. are not entitled for age relaxation.
- (iv) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union for the candidates who served in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Union.
- (v) Three years in addition to the length of service rendered as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC provided the candidate rendered a minimum service of 6 months as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC.
- (vi) Up to a maximum of three years if a candidate is a retrenched temporary employee in the State Census Department with a minimum service of 6 months during 1991.

The prescribed age limits shall not be relaxed under any circumstances, except as specifically provided above.

NOTE: (1) The date of birth accepted by the SLPRB, AP is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. The document relating to age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, service records and etc., will not be accepted.

(2) Due to various Age relaxations, Age validation is not being done in the Online Application Form. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the Candidates to satisfy themselves about their Age eligibility for the Post(s) applied for.

16. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

For the Post Code: 11, 12 & 31

As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must possess a Degree awarded by any University in India, established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provisional Act of State or of any institution recognized by the University Grants Commission or any other equivalent qualification. In the case of a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, as on 1st July, 2026, he/she must have passed Intermediate examination conducted by the competent authority or such other qualification as may be considered equivalent by the state government and should have studied degree in any one of the universities in India.

NOTE:

1. The candidate who possesses higher qualification than the prescribed qualification and the candidate with higher qualification without the prescribed qualification shall also be considered for selection along with candidates who have the prescribed qualification only.

2. **ONUS OF PROOF OF RECOGNITION OF EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:** The Candidates may please note that the onus of proof of recognition of educational qualification by the State Government, in case of doubt, solely rests with the candidate.

The Degrees obtained through open universities / Distance Education mode must have recognition by the Distance Education Council (DEC), Government of India. Unless such degrees have been recognized by the DEC, they will not be accepted for the purpose of Educational Qualification. The onus, in case of doubt, of proof of recognition by the DEC, that the Degrees / Universities have been recognized, rests with the candidate. Candidates may also refer to GO RT No. 143 of HIGHER EDUCATION (EC) DEPARTMENT, Dated 11.07.2018 and the Hon'ble Supreme Court Civil Appeal Nos.17869-17870/2017 (arising out of Special Leave Petition (C) No.s 19807-19808/2012), dated.03.11.2017.

17. MEDICAL STANDARDS:

a. Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows:

i)		<u>Right Eye</u>	<u>Left Eye</u>
(i) Distant Vision	--	6/6	6/6

- ii) Each eye must have a full field of vision.
- iii) Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification.

c. Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any post specified in this rule:

ii) Knocking-knees, pigeon chest, flat feet, Varicose veins, Hammer toes, fractured limbs, decayed teeth, stammering, hard of hearing and abnormal psychological behaviour.

18. FEE STRUCTURE

ii. Candidates having local candidature of Andhra Pradesh belonging to the SC and ST categories shall pay a fee of Rs.300/- only.

A. Mode of Payment of Fee:

II Step: After making the Payment, Candidate has to visit the website **<https://slprb.ap.gov.in>** to submit the STAGE I Online Application

Form. After making payment of fee, if the candidate fails to press “submit” in the STAGE I Online Application Form, such cases shall be rejected without giving any notice, and fee once paid shall not be refunded in any case.

III Step: Candidates who are declared qualified in Preliminary Written Test have to again visit the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> for uploading the STAGE II Application along with the scanned copies of original Certificates / Documents before participating in the PMT/PET.

19. Those who intend to apply for all categories of posts (Post Code Nos 11, 12 & 31), need to submit only **one application form**.

20. CANDIDATES SHOULD ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The candidates applying for the recruitment should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions as given in the notification. Their admission at all stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional and subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Admit card / Hall ticket to the candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by the SLPRB. The SLPRB will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to the genuineness of original documents only after the candidate has finally qualified.

21. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME:

The Selection Procedure / Scheme will be as follows:

A) PRELIMINARY WRITTEN TEST (Post Code Nos. 11,12 &31):

- i. Candidates shall be required to appear for the Preliminary Written Test in two papers (each of three hours duration) as given below. The candidate needs to qualify in each paper. The syllabus for Preliminary Written Test will be from Paper III and IV of **Annexure II** respectively.

NOTE:

1) (a) The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Preliminary Written Test in each paper is 40% for OC (including those claiming EWS reservation), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. Total marks for these two papers will not be counted for the purpose of qualify the candidate.

(b) Candidates belonging to Special Categories i.e. Ex.Servicemen, PE, PM, MSP, CPP, CDI, CSPF, MSPF and NCC shall be secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category in which he/she belongs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. Total marks for these two papers will not be counted for the purpose of qualify the candidate.

2) Questions in Preliminary Written Test in the 1st and 2nd Paper will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose, candidates should bring Blue / Black Ball Point pens along with them.

3) Marks obtained in Preliminary Written Test will have no relevance in the final selection.

INTIMATION LETTER: The candidates who qualify in the Preliminary Written Test will be informed about the dates for downloading the Intimation letter through the website <https://slprb.ap.gov.in> for appearing in the PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS TEST (PMT)/ PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET) with details of Venue, Date and Time. Candidates should bring the Intimation Letter when they come to attend the PMT/PET.

B) PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS TEST (PMT): Candidate who qualifies in the Preliminary Written Test has to undergo Physical Measurements Test and should meet the following requirements:

i. For the Post Code Nos. 11, 12 & 31:

Men:-

- a) Height : Must not be less than 167.6 centimeters.
- b) Chest : Must not be less than 86.3 centimetres round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 5 centimetres.

ii. For the Post Code No. 11 & 12:

Women:

- a) Height : Must not be less than 152.5 centimeters.
- b) Weight : Must not be less than 40 Kgs.

NOTE : Provided that the candidates who belongs to Aboriginal Scheduled Tribes (ABO-ST) in the Agency areas of 1. Vizanagaram, 2. Anakapalli 3. Polavaram 4.Alluri Sitharamaraju (ASR) 5.Eluru and 6.Parvathipuram Manyam Districts should meet the following requirements::

For the Post Code Nos. 11, 12 & 31:

Men:

- a) Height : Must not be less than 160 centimeters.
- b) Chest : Must not be less than 80 centimetres round the chest on full inspiration with a minimum expansion of 3 centimetres.

For the Post Code Nos. 11 & 12:

Women:

- a) Height: Must not be less than 150 Centimeters.
- b) Weight: Must not be less than 38 Kgs.

Note: The Height, Chest and Weight measurements shall be recorded through a digital measurement system. The Height of the candidate shall be measured while the candidate is standing upright in the correct position.

C) PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (PET): Candidate who qualifies in the above Physical Measurement Tests will be required to undergo the following tests and be qualified as specified below:

i. (Post Code No. 11):

Men & Women Candidates must qualify in:

- 1. 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run) and
- 2. One out of the remaining two events of 100 meters run or long jump.

The Physical Efficiency Test will be qualifying in nature, as per the qualifying standards given below:

Men & Women Candidates must qualify in all three events of the Physical Efficiency Test:

1. 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run)
2. 100 meters run and
3. Long jump.

Men & Women candidates must qualify in all three events of the Physical Efficiency Test which carries 100 Marks as detailed below:

The candidates will be given marks for their performance in the above three events as per the gradation table as shown in **Annexure I (A & B).**

iii. (Post Code No. 31) :

Men:- Candidates must qualify in all three events of the Physical Efficiency Test:

1. 1600 Meters run (1 Mile Run)
2. 100 Meters run
3. Long Jump.

These events carry maximum of 100 marks as detailed below:

The candidates will be given marks for their performance in the above three events as per the gradation table as shown in **Annexure I(A).**

Note-1:

1. The events shall be conducted using electronic devices/equipment.
2. Spike shoes shall not be permitted during the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
3. The time taken by the candidate in each event shall be recorded accurately using the prescribed electronic timing system. Any fraction of

a millisecond or delay beyond the prescribed measurement shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of calculation of time.

4. Once any event is conducted as part of the recruitment process, the result thereof shall be treated as final. No second chance, re-test or re-conduct of the event shall be permitted under any circumstances.

Note-2:

Participation in all prescribed events shall be compulsory for every candidate, including candidates belonging to Special Categories.

D) FINAL WRITTEN EXAMINATION (For the Post Code Nos.11,12 & 31)

Candidates who qualify in the above Physical Efficiency Test shall be required to appear for the Final Written Examination in four papers (each of three hours duration) as given below. The syllabus is given in **Annexure II.**

NOTE:

1. (a)The minimum marks to be secured by the candidates in order to qualify in the Final Written Test in each the paper is 40% for OC(including those claiming EWS reservation), 35% for BCs, 30% for SCs/STs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. The marks secured in this Paper-1 & II are qualifying in nature and will not be taken into account for final selection.

(b) Candidates belonging to Special Categories i.e. Ex.Servicemen, PE, PM, MSP, CPP, CDI, CSPF, MSPF and NCC shall be secure the minimum qualifying marks as per their respective communal category which he/she belongs. If a candidate fails to secure qualifying marks even in one paper, he/she will be disqualified. The marks secured in this Paper-1 & II are qualifying in nature and will not be taken into account for final selection.

2. The cases of the candidates who do not secure the minimum qualifying marks in these papers (Papers I and II), will not be considered for further selection process irrespective of their performance in papers III & IV.

3. Questions in Papers III and IV will be objective in nature and will be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. The candidates can choose to have the question papers in one of the three languages and should indicate his / her choice as and when asked for by the recruiting authority. Option once exercised will be final and a candidate will not be allowed to change it subsequently.

Note:- Revaluation of Answer Sheets will not be entertained under any circumstances. However, the Re-counting of marks may be considered.

4. The candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only. For this purpose candidates should bring Blue / Black Ball Point pens along with them.

5. Candidates will have to mention their option of Language in which he/she will write Written Examination while submitting Application Forms.

E) FINAL SELECTION:

I. For Post Code No.11 (Men & women): The final selection of the candidates (Men & Women) will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their aggregate score of Paper III (200 Marks) and Paper IV (200 Marks) total 400 marks will be taken into account for final selection. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,2025” are applicable for the post of SI (Civil) specified in G.O.Ms.No.103, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.07.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

II. For Post Code No. 12 (Men & women): The final selection of the Candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their aggregate score of Paper III (100 Marks) and Paper IV (100 Marks) of the Final Written Examination and the Physical Efficiency Test (100 marks), totalling to 300 marks. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public

Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025 are applicable for the post of RSI (AR) specified in G.O.Ms.No.105, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.07.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

III. For Post Code No. 31 (Men): The final selection of the Candidates will be made strictly on relative merit, as obtained by them based on their aggregate score of Paper III (100 Marks) and Paper IV (100 Marks) of the Final Written Examination and the Physical Efficiency Test (100 marks), totalling to 300 marks. The provisions of “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025” are applicable for the post of SI (SPF) specified in G.O.Ms.No.191, G.A.(SPF&MC) Department., dated :15.09.2026.

As per G.O.Ms.No. 172 G.A. (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 02.09.2026 and further amendment thereon, while filling up of the posts under direct recruitment the first 05% of posts should be filled locals and non-locals candidates on the basis of merit in Open Competition and thereafter, the remaining 95% of the posts shall be filled up by locals only.

NOTE: When two or more candidates in a particular category obtain equal marks, preference will be given to the candidate who was born earlier.

22. RESERVATION TO LOCAL CANDIDATES (POST CODE No.11 & 12):
DEFINITION OF LOCAL CANDIDATE:

Reservation to Local Candidates shall be applicable as per The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025, issued vide G.O.Ms.No.45, General Administration (SPF&MC) Department, dated 20.04.2026. Candidates claiming Local Candidate reservation shall submit the required Study Certificate(s) from Class I to Class VII, issued by the concerned Government/Government-recognized School Authorities (Annexure-III(A)). If the candidate has not studied in any Government/Government-recognized school during any part of the seven-year period, a Residence Certificate for that period, issued by the Tahsildar of the concerned Mandal, shall be submitted for determining Local Status (Annexure-III(B)).

NOTE: Single certificate, whether of study or residence would suffice for enabling the candidate to apply as a “Local Candidate”.

(i) If, however, a candidate has resided in more than one Mandal during the relevant four/seven years’ period but within the same District, separate certificates from the Mandal Revenue Officers exercising jurisdiction has to be obtained in respect of different areas.

NOTE: Residence certificate will not be accepted, if a candidate has studied in any educational institution up to 7th class or equivalent examination. Invariably, such candidates have to produce study certificates only. The candidates, who acquired Degree from Open Universities without studying SSC/Matriculation or equivalent in educational institutions, have to submit residence certificate only.

Reservation to local candidates is applicable as provided in the Rules and as amended from time to time as in force on the date of notification. The candidates claiming reservation as local candidates should enclose the required Study certificates from I class to VII class. In case he/she has not studied from I class to VII class in one particular district Residence Certificate, in the given proforma only, should be enclosed for those candidates who have not studied in any Educational Institutions.

NOTE: As per G.S.R. 775 (E) read with GSR 591 (E): The candidates who migrated to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of Ten years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his / her residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of employment.

Candidates who are covered by this order will be required to submit necessary certificate as per the instructions given by the Government of Andhra Pradesh at the time of appearing for Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test (Only those candidates who qualify for Preliminary Written Test).

23. SPECIAL REPRESENTATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

As per G.O.Ms.No. 173, Home (Legal-II) Department, dated 16.09.2026, all vacancies arising under the Special Categories shall be applicable exclusively to candidates who are local to the State of Andhra Pradesh, in accordance with “The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2025” and the rules and orders in force.

As per G.O. Ms No. 87 of HOME (LEGAL-II) dated: 15- July- 2016 and subsequent amendments thereon, the vacancies reserved for special categories shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner on compartmental basis, that is the reservation of special category candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective communal category to which the candidate belongs.

A. Percentage of Quota in the Special Categories:

i) **For Post Code Nos. 11:** 5% for Police Executive (PE); 3% for Meritorious Sports Persons (MSP); 3% for NCC; 2% for Ex-Servicemen; 2% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP) and 2% for CDI; 1% for Police Ministerial (PM).

ii) **For Post Code Nos. 12:** 7% for Police Executive (PE); 3% for Meritorious Sports Persons (MSP); 3% for NCC; 2% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP); and 2% for CDI; 2% for Ex-Servicemen; 1% for Police Ministerial (PM).

iii) **For Post Code No. 31:** 5% for Members of Special Protection Force (MSPF); 3% for Meritorious Sports Persons (MSP); 3% for Children of SPF (CSPF) including Retired/Deceased/Incapacities; 2% for Ex-Servicemen; and 2% for NCC.

24. Candidates who claim reservation / quota under the special categories should satisfy the following conditions:

i) **PE (Police Executive):** Police Constables, Head Constables and Assistant Sub Inspectors of Police working in A.P. Police Dept., who are approved probationers and who have completed three years of service as on the date of notification will come under this special category. The period rendered as Stipendiary Cadet Trainee shall not be counted for purpose of service.

NOTE: Candidates who fall under any of the following categories will not be considered for quota under 'Police Executive' (PE).

- a) Any major punishment in the entire service.
- b) Minor punishments - three or more in the entire service.
- c) Any punishment under operation
- d) Under suspension or facing an oral enquiry
- e) Whoever declared as deserter from service for any reason
- f) Compulsorily retired or removed from service

ii) MSP (Meritorious Sportsperson) – "Meritorious Sportsperson" means a sportsperson who has represented the State of Andhra Pradesh or the Country in recognized sports events at the national or international level or secured a medal either in State level Competition or in the All India Inter - University competitions conducted by the Inter-University Boards in any of the games, sports mentioned in G.O. Ms. No. 56 GA (SER.D) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026; and any other games / sports as may be specified by the Government from time to time:

- a. As per G.O.Ms.No.25, YAT&C (Sports & YS) Department, dated 15.05.2026 written tests and events are mandatory for applicant for selection under sports quota.
- b. Priority will be given based on the level of sports achievement as per the priority list prescribed at Section-VIII in G.O.Ms.No. 25 YAT & C (Sps & YS) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026 for the best achievement made by the meritorious sportsperson during the eligible period.
- c. Resolution of Tie Cases: - In the event of a tie between two or more candidates holding equal priority at the highest level.
 - i. Preference shall be given to the candidate having a greater number of similar high-level sports achievements.
 - ii. If the tie persists, preference shall be given to the candidate possessing a greater number of sports achievements at the next lower level.
 - iii. If the tie still persists, preference shall be given to the candidate who is elder in age.

Note: (1) While filling up the vacancies, preference shall be given to Category-A disciplines. Category-B disciplines will be considered only if vacancies remain unfilled by Category-A candidates (As mentioned in the G.O.Ms.No. 25 YAT & C (Sps & YS) Dept., dtd: 15.05.2026.

(2) Candidates who claim reservation quota under Meritorious Sports Person category should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificates in Annexures- X, XI, XII & XIII as the case may be, of this notification.

iii) **NCC – National Cadet Corps:** Candidates who possess NCC ‘C’ certificate will be preferred. If sufficient candidates are not available, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘B’ certificate will be considered. If vacancies still remain unfilled, then the candidates who possess NCC ‘A’ certificate will be considered.

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation / quota under NCC (A/B/C) should submit the necessary certificate.

iv) Ex-Servicemen: Candidates who claim reservation as Ex-Servicemen should satisfy the conditions mentioned in Rule 2 (16) of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules and should have the necessary certificate from the competent authority.

“Ex-Servicemen” means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as a non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union, but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Research Engineering Force, Lok-Sahayak Sena and the para-military forces, i.e., Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police, Central Industrial Security Force, Central Secretariat Security Force, Assam Rifles and Railway Protection Force and

- (i) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension; or
- (ii) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
- (iii) who has been released, otherwise than on his own request, from such service as a result of reduction in establishment or
- (iv) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct, inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories; namely:-
 - (a) pension holders for continuous embodied services;
 - (b) person with disability attributable to military services; and
 - (c) gallantry award winners.

Explanation: The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of ex-servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.

v) CPP: Children of Police Personnel up to the rank of Inspector of Police in AP Police Department who are either in service or retired or dead, will come under this special category.

NOTE: Children of police personnel who were compulsorily retired or removed or dismissed from service will not be considered for quota under “Children of Police Personnel” (CPP).

vi) CDI: (1) Children of Police Personnel of A.P. Police Department who (a) died due to violent action of the extremists/criminals/anti-social elements or (b) were incapacitated and were retired on medical invalidation due to violent action of the extremists/criminals/anti-social elements and

(2) Children of Police Personnel of Andhra Pradesh Police Department who (a) died due to violence while on duty or (b) were incapacitated and were retired on medical invalidation due to violence while on duty.

vii) PM (Police Ministerial): Persons working in A.P. Police Department in the ranks which correspond to the following categories as specified in Rule 2 of A.P. Ministerial Service Rules, 1998 will come under this special category, provided they are approved probationers and have completed three years of service as on the date of notification:

- a) Category (2) and (3) of Class – A
- b) Category (2) and (4) of Class – B

NOTE: Candidates who fall under any of the following categories will not be considered for quota under ‘Police Ministerial’ (PM)

- a) Any major punishment in the entire service.
- b) Minor punishments - three or more in the entire service.
- c) Any punishment under operation
- d) Under suspension or facing an oral enquiry
- e) Whoever declared as deserter from service for any reason
- f) Compulsorily retired or removed from service

viii) Children of SPF members including Retired / Deceased / Incapacitated members (CSPF): Children of permanent serving members of Special Protection Force up to the rank of Inspector including children of retired, deceased, incapacitated or compulsorily retired on medical Invalidation shall come under this special category.

Note: Children of members of Special Protection Force who were compulsorily retired, removed or dismissed from service as a measure of punishment shall not be considered under this special category.

ix) Members of Special Protection Force (MSPF): Members enrolled as permanent members of the Special Protection Force in any class and

category of Special Protection Force service including Ministerial Service and who have completed three years of service as on the date of notification will come under this special category. The period rendered as Stipendiary Cadet Trainee shall not be counted for purpose of service.

Note: Candidates who fall under any of the following categories will not be considered for quota under "Members of Special Protection"

- (a) Any major punishment in the entire service.
- (b) Minor punishments three or more in the entire service.
- (c) Any punishment under currency
- (d) Under suspension or facing an oral enquiry
- (e) Dismissed, Compulsory retired or removed from service"

NOTE: Candidates who claim reservation/quota under PE, PM, CPP, CDI, CSPF & MSPF special categories should satisfy the above conditions and submit the certificate as per annexure IV, V, VI, VII, VIII & IX respectively, as the case may be. The certificate(s) pertaining to PE, PM, CPP or CDI should be obtained on or after the date of notification from the competent authority. **The certificate obtained before the date of notification is not valid and will not be entertained.**

25. Recruitment to all the posts, including those of special categories, shall be made as per the provisions of "The Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local cadres and regulation of direct recruitment) Order, 2025" and further amendments thereon.

26. The selection of the candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of the genuineness of original certificates, antecedents and medical examination.

27. ANTECEDENTS VERIFICATION: No person shall be eligible for appointment to any service by direct recruitment unless he / she satisfies the selection authority as well as the appointing authority that his / her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him / her for such service.

28. DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT: The candidates falling under the following categories shall be disqualified for appointment, under these rules:

- i. If any document produced by the candidate is found fake or forged as established during antecedent verification.

- ii. If the candidate himself or through his relatives or friends or any other has canvassed or endeavoured to enlist extraneous support whether from official or non-official sources for his / her candidature.
- iii. A person (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person. Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- iv. A person who has been dismissed from the services of a State or Central Government or from the service of any Central or State Government undertaking or local body or other authority.
- v. A person who has been convicted for any offence or facing trial in any court of law, except for offences of technical nature like Motor Vehicles Act Violations, J.J. Act (Juvenile Justice) Violations, shall stand disqualified.
- vi. A person who is involved in an offence involving moral turpitude is disqualification for appointment.

29. In the event of any information being found false or incorrect or ineligibility being detected at any time even after appointment, he / she will be discharged from service forthwith by the appointing authority without giving any notice.

30. STIPEND AND ALLOWANCE During the period of institutional training (for Post Code Nos. 11 & 12) (regular as well as extended) candidates shall be eligible for stipend as fixed by the Government from time to time.

31. After successful completion of training, they will be appointed in the regular time scale of Pay as mentioned herein.

Scale of Pay: For Post Code No. 11,12 & 31: Rs 44,570 – 1,27,480/- as per Revised Pay Scale 2022.

32. The employees who are appointed on or after 01-09-2004 are covered by the Contributory Pension Scheme.

33. Time limit for submission of attestation forms (or) other relevant documents (or) attend medical examination (or) join the training: As per G.O.Ms.No. 101 Home (Legal.II) Department, dated: 16.02.2009, the

candidates who were provisionally selected for any one of the post specified in these rules, will be asked to submit an attestation form, produce other relevant documents and attend medical examination on a specified date. The candidates who become eligible to be sent for training will be asked join the training on a specified date. If any candidate fails to respond and submit the necessary form or document or fails to attend the medical examination or fails to join the training on a specified date, his / her provisional selection shall be cancelled without giving prior notice to the candidate.

34. General Instructions:

- i. Particulars furnished by the Candidates in the Application Form will be taken as final. Candidates should, therefore, be very careful in uploading / submitting the Application Form Online.
- ii. Incomplete / Incorrect Application Form will be summarily rejected. The information, if any, furnished by the Candidate subsequently in any form will not be entertained by the SLPRB, AP under any circumstances. Candidates should be careful in filling up the Application Form before submission. If any lapse is detected at any stage of the recruitment process, the candidature will be instantly rejected.
- iii. Serving personnel of the Army, Navy, Air Force or Territorial Army of the Indian Union who are due to retire within one year from the last date prescribed for submission of the Stage-I Online Application Form shall produce a “No Objection Certificate (NOC)” issued by their respective Unit Commanding Officer, duly indicating the Personnel Number, Rank, Name, Unit and Date of Retirement, or the Retirement Order, as applicable, for claiming age relaxation and/or reservation under the Ex-Servicemen category.
- iv. Based on the information submitted by the candidate, at the time of STAGE I Online Application Form, (i.e. Community, Local & Non-Local, Ex-servicemen certificate, EWS and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate etc.), the Preliminary Written Test results will be issued. If any information is later found false, the candidature of such candidate shall be rejected, without giving notice and prior intimation.
- v. Candidates must submit all the relevant certificates during the process of physical verification of the certificates at the time of PMT/PET. No further submission of certificate will be entertained/received by SLPRB, AP at later stage.

- vi. The provisional selection list shall be prepared based on the preferences indicated by the candidate in the Application Form as per the eligibility (i.e. Post Preference and Unit Preference). Candidature will not be considered against those Posts / Units which were left blank / or were left unfilled by the Candidate.
- vii. Candidates are advised to carefully read and understand all the instructions before submitting the Online Application Form. By submitting the application form, the candidate has acknowledged acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the notification.

- xi. ***The SLPRB, AP reserves the right to issue corrigendum/supplementary notifications time to time in case there is any modification in rules or in the recruitment process.***

35. CERTIFICATES TO BE BROUGHT BY CANDIDATE AT THE TIME OF PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT TEST:

Those candidates who qualify Preliminary Written Test and are called for Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test shall bring, IN PERSON, the following documents in original along with one set of Xerox copy duly attested by a Gazetted Officer while coming for attending Physical Measurement Test (PMT) & Physical Efficiency Test (PET) compulsorily. Failure to produce the same will lead to rejection of the candidature and no additional time shall be given.

- a). ***Secondary School / Matriculation certificate or equivalent certificate in support of the date of birth.***
- b). ***Educational qualification: As on 1st July, 2026, the candidate must possess a Degree awarded by any University in India, established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provisional Act of State or of any institution recognised by the University Grants Commission or any other equivalent qualification. In the case of a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, as on 1st July, 2026, he/she must have passed Intermediate Examination conducted by the competent authority or such other qualification as may be considered equivalent by the State Government and should have studied degree in any one of the university in India.***
- c). ***A candidate belonging to the Open Category (OC), who wish to claim concession in age and reservation specified for the EWS category, should submit the said Certificate (issued on or after 01-04-2026) by the competent authority as specified (Para no. 13).***

- f). ***Certificate from the competent authority in respect of State Government employees/those who worked in the Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union/NCC Instructors/ retrenched temporary employees in the State Census Department during 1991 for claiming age relaxation.***
- g). ***Residence certificate in the agency area from the competent authority in respect of candidates belonging to Aboriginal***

Scheduled Tribes in the agency areas who have claimed relaxation in physical measurements.

- h). Study certificate (i.e. from 1st to 7th class) issued by the School authorities or Residence certificate (in case the candidate has not studied in any Educational Institution preceding to 7th Class) issued by Tahasildar of the concerned Mandal, for determining local status (Annexure- III(A) & III(B)).***
- i). Police Executive service certificate / Police Ministerial service certificate / Certificate of CPP and Certificate of CDI, wherever applicable/ Children of SPF members including Retired / Deceased / Incapacitated members (CSPF)/ Members of Special Protection Force (MSPF).***
- j). Ex-servicemen certificate and NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate etc., wherever applicable.***
- k). Meritorious Sportspersons certificates pertaining to Category (A) and (B) disciplines in the form of Annexures mentioned below (Annexure- X, XI, XII & XIII).***
- l). The candidate who migrated to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of Ten years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall submit relevant certificate in order to claim local candidate status (Para No. 22).***

36. The SLPRB, AP reserves the right to take decision regarding conduct of examination and selecting candidates as per rules. The decision of the SLPRB, AP shall be final in all aspects. Further, SLPRB, AP may modify and reschedule the Examination / Test due to unforeseen circumstances. **Candidates are required to visit the website of SLPRB, AP regularly to keep himself / herself updated until completion of the recruitment process.** The SLPRB website information is final for all correspondence. No individual correspondence by any means will be entertained under any circumstances.

PAPER I:

ENGLISH (DEGREE STANDARD) (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE)

The candidate's understanding of the English language, its correct usage and his/her writing ability would be tested. Questions on short essay, comprehension, précis, letter writing, paragraph writing / report writing, translation from English to Telugu etc. would be included.

PAPER II:

TELUGU (DEGREE STANDARD) (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE)

The candidate's understanding of the Telugu language, its correct usage and his/her writing ability would be tested. Questions on short essay, comprehension, précis, letter writing, paragraph writing / report writing, translation from Telugu to English etc. would be included.

OR

URDU (DEGREE STANDARD) (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE)

The candidate's understanding of the Urdu language, its correct usage and his/her writing ability would be tested. Questions on short essay, comprehension, précis, letter writing, paragraph writing / report writing, translation from Urdu to English etc. would be included.

**PAPER III: ARITHMETIC (SSC STANDARD) & TEST OF REASONING /
MENTAL ABILITY (OBJECTIVE TYPE) (200 QUESTIONS)**

Arithmetic: It will include questions on problems relating to number system, simple interest, compound interest, ratio & proportion, average, percentage, profit & loss, time & work, work & wages, time & distance, clocks & calendars, partnership, mensuration etc.

Test of Reasoning: It will include questions of both verbal & non-verbal type and include question on analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualisation, spatial orientation, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory etc.

PAPER IV: GENERAL STUDIES (DEGREE STANDARD) (OBJECTIVE TYPE) (200 QUESTIONS)

General Science - contemporary developments in science and technology and their implications including matters of everyday observation and experience, contemporary issues relating to protection of environment as may be expected of a well educated person who has not made a special study of any scientific discipline.
2. Current events of national and international importance.
3. History of India – emphasis will be on broad general understanding of the subject in its social, economic, cultural and political aspects. Indian National Movement.
4. Geography of India
5. Indian Polity and Economy – including the Country’s political system, rural development, planning and economic reforms in India.

*The questions relating to “English in the syllabus” will be set in English only in the Telugu / Urdu version of the question paper also.
